To the recipients of Unemployment Insurance

File a proper report, receive the correct benefit

Please, fill out the Declaration of Unemployment form as it is

1. If you have performed any work, report the fact as it is (regardless of whether you earned any income.)

✓ When you do temporary work such as part-time, temporary job, daily employment



✓ When you decide to get a job (including trial period and training period.)



✓ When you worked in-house or helped out



✓ Upon assuming as a board member (including part-time, regardless of income.)



✓ When you start self-employment (including the preparation period.)



2. Report honestly the actual content of your job search activities.

For example, do not falsely report activities such as the following, even if you have not actually carried out job search activities.

Talked to an agent online



month○ day△
Applied to company "A"



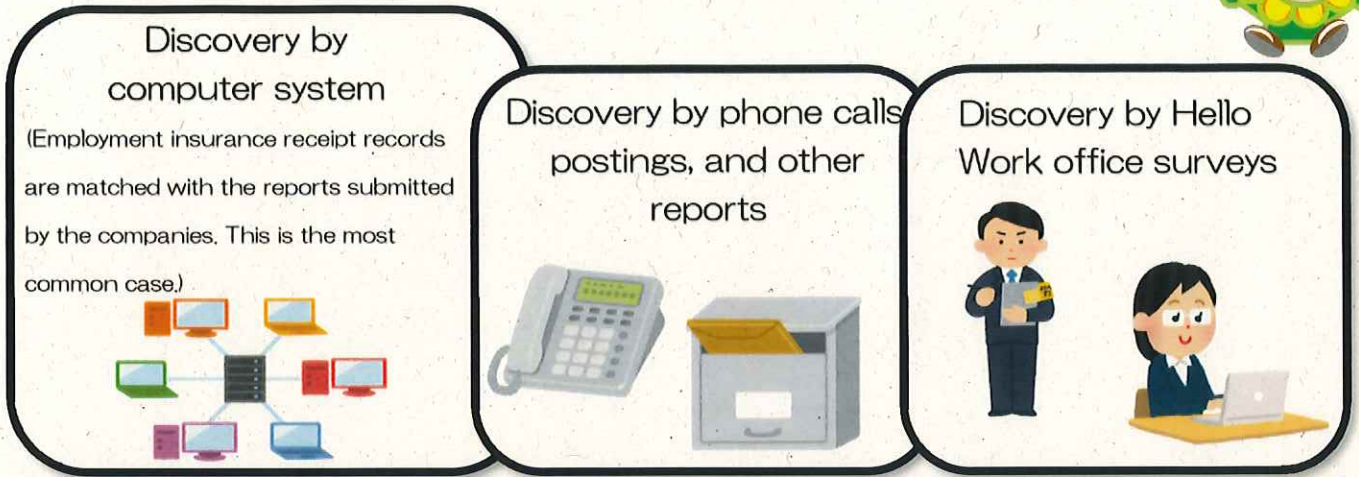
3. In addition to 1 and 2...

- Attempting to receive unemployment benefits with an Unemployment Certificate (*irishokuhyo*) containing false or fictitious information (period of employment, date of separation from employment, amount of wages, etc.) or with a Unemployment Certificate (*irishokuhyo*) in someone else's name.
- Attempting to receive unemployment benefits by concealing the receipt of workers' compensation benefits (*rousai hoken*) that are provided when a person is unable to work due to illness or injury.

Failure to report these correctly will result in fraudulent benefits.

False statements are discovered in this way

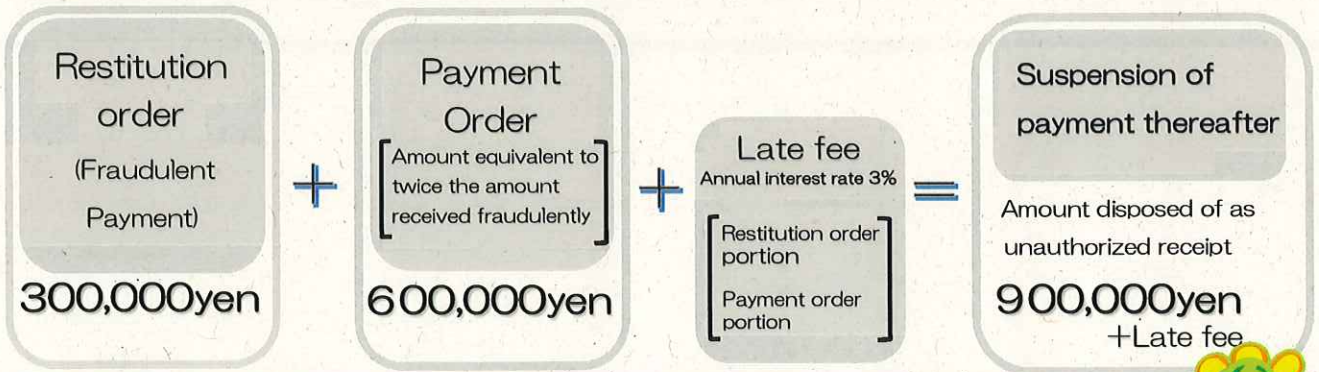


If you engage in fraudulent receipt of benefits, you will receive severe punishment.



<p>Restitution Order</p> <p>You must return the amount received fraudulently or thereafter, in full.</p>	<p>Payment Order</p> <p>You may have to pay an amount equal to or less than twice the amount of the restitution order.</p>	<p>Suspension of benefits</p> <p>You will not be entitled to any benefits after the date of failure to file a correct report.</p>

For example, if the fraudulent amount received is 300,000 yen...
 In addition to the suspension of payment, you may have to pay 900,000 yen or more.



- If you have been penalized for receiving benefits improperly
- You may be criminally punished for fraud.
 - Failure to return the money may result in seizure of property.
