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Introducing Counseling Line for Foreign Workers

The Japanese Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare has established a ‘Consultation Line for Foreign Workers’ to respond to questions from foreign workers in English, Chinese, and other 11 different languages.

This helpline will assist in explaining laws and regulations as well as making referrals to relevant agencies, etc. on issues related to working conditions.

Calls to ‘Consultation Line for Foreign Workers’ will be charged at 8.5yen/180 seconds if calling by landline (tax included), 10 yen/20 seconds if calling by mobile phone (tax included).

Introducing Hotline to Advise on Working Conditions

The Labour Standards Advice Hotline is a commissioned service entrusted by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare. The hotline offers free general advice on working conditions from anywhere in Japan during the hours when the Prefectural Labour Bureaus and Labour Standards Inspection Offices are closed or in weekends and holidays. Foreign language support is also available.
