# Job searching procedure

# Reception

Present your residence card and passport (Designation paper if granted).

If you are already registered in any Hello Work, bring your registration paper.

If you wish to search for jobs by yourself, you can use our terminal (Available only in Japanese).

## Job counseling

- We search for jobs based on your requests and qualifications.
- O We give support for preparing documents needed for job application (CV, resume, etc.).
- O We confirm job conditions in detail with potential employers. If you are eligible to apply, we assist your application and issue a letter of introduction.

## You can search by yourself

You can also search by yourself. If you find a potential job, print out the page and bring it to the reception. If you are eligible, we will issue a letter of introduction which is necessary for application.



## Visa information

A specialist is available to advise on visa status and immigration procedures.
